

Baker High School (Baker City) — \$5,000

for Community 101 student grantmaking

Blue Mountain Community College (Pendleton) — \$25,000

for scholarships

Blue Mountain Healthcare Foundation (John Day) — \$8,250

for the purchase of pellet boiler for Blue Mountain Hospital, to serve as its primary heating source and reduce the hospital's reliance on oil heat

Blue Mountain Humane Association (La Grande) — \$5,000

for support of the Mollie Atwater and Friends Spay/Neuter Program

Building Healthy Families (Enterprise) — \$40,000

for support of the Youth Enrichment Project, providing mentoring programs/projects for youth to strengthen academic support, build positive relationships with adults, and engage in leadership and entrepreneurship curriculum - Eastern Oregon Regional Action Initiative

Building Healthy Families (Enterprise) — \$80,000

to provide support for a Hub model collaboration for the delivery of best practice parenting education programs through home visiting, classes, child care provider trainings and community events in Wallowa and Baker counties

Community Connection of Northeast Oregon (La Grande) — \$6,000

for support of Kids Club, an after-school center for children in La Grande

Eastern Oregon Regional Arts Council (La Grande) — \$10,000

for the Oregon Writing Project to partner with Fishtrap and ArtsEast to provide a cohesive infusion of writing-related enrichment events for young people in rural Oregon small schools - Eastern Oregon Regional Action Initiative

Families First of Grant County, Inc. (John Day) — \$40,000

to introduce to the community the 40 Developmental Assets and provide a family enrichment coordinator that will link families, schools, agencies and services to ensure that all families are utilizing available opportunities in Grant County - Eastern Oregon Regional Action Initiative

Grant County Family Heritage Foundation (Seneca) — \$9,850

for the Grant County Fairgrounds kitchen project and for general operating support for the Grant County Family Heritage Foundation

Harney County Arts in Education Foundation (Hines) — \$5,000

for support of a regional centennial celebration of the founding of the Sagebrush Orchestra, which will include a concert by the Portland Youth Philharmonic and the launch of a regional Performing Arts Center planning council
