

Bandon High School (Bandon) — \$5,000

for Community 101 student grantmaking

Brookings-Harbor School District 17-C (Brookings) — \$5,000

for Community 101 student grantmaking

Coos Art Museum (Coos Bay) — \$3,600

for general support

Coos County Public Health Department (North Bend) — \$80,000

to hire a dental health coordinator for Coos and Curry counties - South Coast Regional Action Initiative

Coquille Valley Historical Society and Museum (Coquille) — \$7,819

for structural repairs of the Museum

Curry Soil & Water Conservation District (Gold Beach) — \$12,500

to reach over 600 5th - 8th grade students, 20 teachers, and 50 parents through the South Coast Foodshed project, exploring the foodsheds of southern Oregon, creating several school gardens, interviewing local farmers and ranchers, and understanding the wider food distribution system

Curry/Del Norte Orchestra Guild (Gold Beach) — \$3,000

for expansion of the garden at Great Afternoons, a childcare, pre-K and after-school facility

Oregon Coast Community Action (Coos Bay) — \$10,000

for a second and final year of support for the expansion of the Share Bear Snack Pack Program, providing needy children with food on weekends and school vacations
