Coalition of Oregon Land Trusts (Eugene) — \$30,000

to hire a coordinator to roll out priorities identified in the organization's new strategic plan

Cottage Grove Economic and Business Improvement District (Cottage Grove) — \$18,000

to build organizational and operational capacity to promote economic development and employment in Cottage Grove

Friends of Tryon Creek State Park (Portland) — \$15,000

to build organizational capacity through improved fundraising and marketing

Habitat for Humanity-Portland/Metro East (Portland) — \$15,000

for the new mortgage service coordinator

Hands on Greater Portland (Portland) — \$20,000

to evolve the service model to leverage the current volunteer "boom" to help nonprofit partners meet growing community needs
