

Altrusa Club of Roseburg Foundation (Roseburg) — \$1,500

to teach children and families that reading is essential and fun through a 2-week Celebration of Literacy motivational program that impacts 25,000 children and adults

Camp Millennium (Roseburg) — \$5,000

to support Camp Millenium, a week-long summer camp for children ages 5 - 16 dealing with cancer

CASA of Douglas County (Roseburg) — \$5,000

to provide the support and infrastructure for enough CASA's to serve 85% of the 420 children in foster care in Douglas County

Community Cancer Foundation (Roseburg) — \$10,000

to support the costs of treatment for uninsured and underinsured cancer patients

Family Development Center / Douglas County Relief Nursery (Roseburg) — \$8,000

to provide therapeutic, educational and family support services for children

Family Relief Nursery (South Lane) (Cottage Grove) — \$5,000

to provide education in independent living skills, job readiness, and parenting skills to pregnant teens and young women with babies who are homeless or in unsafe situations

SMART (Portland) — \$3,000

to provide free books to 300 students in Douglas County
