### **Latino Partnership Program 2010 Grants**

**CAUSA Oregon** – \$7,000 for a central Oregon coordinator to do outreach to Jefferson County

**Central Oregon Community College Foundation** – \$12,500 for support of the Oregon Leadership Institute

**La Luz del Valle Church** – \$1,992 for the Mid-Valley Literacy Center to conduct three tutor trainings to deliver literacy programs for adults

**Latino Community Association** – \$800 for registration, transportation and overnight costs for Latina women to attend the Latina Empowerment Conference in Portland

**Multicultural Association of Southern Oregon** – \$1,500 for Ballet Folklórico Ritmo Alegre to train two new dance instructors
